Modo offers two-way, roundtrip carsharing. Each of its vehicles has a designated parking space, with cars picked up and dropped off at the same location. Two Modo vehicles are stationed at the Central Saanich municipal hall on Wallace and Mt. Newton X Rd. Modo is a member-owned carshare operator in BC.
