Please join us for the Grand Opening Ceremony scheduled for <u>Saturday, June</u> <u>4, 2022 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm</u>. The location is at the foot of Lisnoe Avenue where it meets Mount Newton Cross Road.



What started out as a vision to support local and visiting cyclists with a place to park their bikes while they enjoy the community or jump on the bus to commute to/from work, will be so much more. We see it as a gathering place for the community, as is represented in the artwork by local First Nations artist, Sarah Jim.

Sarah Jim is an emerging artist of Coast Salish, Mexican, and Russian-Jewish ancestry. She is a proud member of the WSÁNEĆ nation from the Tseycum village.

To Sarah, kelp forests are a significant aspect of underwater ecosystems as they provide shelter, hunting grounds, and nurseries for so many creatures. Currents move slowly throughout these forests which make them a safe habitat and mitigate coastal erosion. Bull kelp also plays a key role in reducing the effects of climate change by sequestering carbon. These forests represent community, as countless creatures gather in these special places.
