## **Annual General Meeting**

The SVA Annual General Meeting was held February 18, 2025 at the Saanich Pioneer Museum with a large number of Saanichton residents and business members in attendance. Participants were also happy to welcome Debra Greenaway (Beacon Community Services), Cpl. Pat Bryant (Central Saanich Police Service), and Gord Newton (Central Saanich Councillor).

As reported to the meeting, major initiatives the SVA was involved in last year included the Community Dinner held in March, and two outdoor movie nights in August. The 20th Annual Christmas in the Village was held on December 7th, raising \$11,000 for the Saanich Peninsula Lions Food Bank.


Debra Greenaway gave a presentation on Beacon Community Services. They have been on the Peninsula for 50 years and offer a range of services for everyone from infants to seniors. Beacon has childcare facilities, an office for Children's Programs and Childcare Referral, and works to connect families with the resources needed. Multiple resources for seniors and the low income population on the peninsula are available, ranging from income tax preparation to companion care, to housing.

Cpl. Bryant talked about the partnership between Beacon and the Central Saanich Police Service, and emphasized the need for partnership and collaboration with all organizations in our community.


